## Circular on an educational excursion - for Grade 8

TO: PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OF STUDENTS FROM CLASS 8.

Dear Parents,

Please note that our school is planning for an educational excursion to Sahyadri School and to Pune Class VIII. The students will leave the campus at 11 PM on the 10th January for Sahyadri School, about 25 kms from Rajgurunagar. Sahyadri School is part of the Krishnamurti Foundation of India. They will reach this respected and progressive school in the early hours of 11th morning. They will interact with the students of that school and look around the place. On the 12th afternoon they will leave for Pune. They will return on the 15th morning to Nasik. It is mandatory for all the day scholars to attend the excursion because it is of immense significance. The parents of day scholars may kindly deposit Rs. 7000 as additional imprest deposit for the excursion by the 5th January, 2012. The yearly boarders, except those with outstanding fees and imprest accounts, need not pay the additional deposit. The expense will be charged to the imprest account. Our school will charge for the excursion from the day scholars even if the child does not participate in it.

The day scholars will need to bring their bag to the school on 10th morning, as per the list which will be given by the 5th January, and leave for the excursion from school campus along with the hostel children. On the way back the day scholars will be dropped at our city office by 6.00 AM on the 15th morning and parents will have to collect their children. If the parent or guardian is not available to collect at that time, the child will be brought to the school campus and requests of any other kind will not be honored because we have to take care of all the other children too.

The excursion will take them visit to places like Aga Khan Palace, IUCAA, Saras Baugh, Alandi and a few other places of Pune. There might be minor changes in the program. There will be enough teachers and staff of the excursion organizers to take care of the children in all respects.
