1	On Admission being granted the fees (Security Deposit, Imprest Advance and first installment of Annual fees) should be paid before first day of school		
2	Regular defaulters of the Fee payment will be re- considered for admission in the next session by the principal.		
3	Payments must be made in favor of "Kalyani Charitable Trust's , Orchid International School" by Bank Draft or Banker's Cheque payable at Nashik.		
4	Applicable Annual Fees needs to be paid before the first day of school of the respective term.		
5	Habitual delay in Payment of fees may invite financial penalty of 2% per month.		
6	Security Deposit will not be refunded in case the student is withdrawn from School without prior withdrawal notice of 90 days.		
7	The imprest statement will be given to the Parents on the last working day of each term with general details of the expense.		
8	Please note that in case the expenditure exceeds the imprest advance amount, the parent is liable to pay the excess amount.		
9	Admission fee of Rs. 15000 and Refundable Security Deposit will become payable when child moves out of Pre Primary to the higher		
10	Students admitted under as residential scholars cannot be converted as day boarders during that particular academic year.		
11	Absence from School for more than 6 consecutive days without prior approval by the Principal will result in the student's name being struck off the rolls.		
12	The fees will remain firm for three years or for that particular stage, whichever is lesser or earlier. After 3 years there will be an increase of 20 to 25% in the fee.		
13	The school will not be able to make arrangements to collect fees. The parents will have to pay at the school office. Any bank charges applicable will be borne by the parents.		
14	In case a cheque issued by a parent bounces the school will issue a letter blacklisting the parent. A penalty may also be charged from such parents.
