Dear and Respected Parent/ Guardian,

Sub: Reminder on critical matters

As you are aware our school has a certain kind of profound educational vision, which has deeper and wider implications for better and more wholesome development and growth of children. We have shared with you some aspects of our educational vision and approach with you during the seminar on education arranged for parents some months back. We have also given you ample reading material on these issues. We would like to take up our educational endeavor more seriously next year by having all children on campus for extended periods of time - without the weekends causing disruption in our endeavor. Keeping that in mind we have introduced interesting and enriched activities/exposures for our children on Saturday evenings and Sundays. We will be adding further possibilities to the available options from June 2010.

We observe that the all round development of children is cognizably better in the case of the yearly boarding students compared to the weekly system and day boarding system students. The growth and development in case of weekly system students appears to be somewhat more pronounced and better than what the day scholar's experience - when we keep the overall development aspects of the children in mind. These remarks are based on the considered view and opinion of some of our faculty members, including me.

We would hence like to **urge you to consider conversion to yearly system for your child from the next academic year, viz. 2010-2011**. The day boarding system is **not being discontinued for the next academic year**.

In the meanwhile we want to remind you on the following points

Repeated misbehavior by a student with driver, students and teachers in the bus will disqualify him from using the school bus facility.

Students bringing disallowed items to the school for himself or herself or for other students will be viewed seriously and disciplinary steps including suspension or expulsion can be taken by us.

Usage of foul, abusive or uncouth language by a student in the school bus is not acceptable.
