Dear and Respected Parents/Guardians,

Sub: Special provisions for parent-child communication prior to and during ICSE 2010.

We feel and understand that the affectionate and soft touch of parents and guardians is required by the children of Class 10, who will take the ICSE in March 2010, for the next two months, more frequently. During this phase of intensive study it might be necessary for the children to receive the emotional support and counsel of parents/guardians in addition to the counsel provided by our teachers more often. Keeping these needs in mind we have made the following additional/special communication provisions for the next two months for students of Class 10.

Parents can make one call every week (instead of one every fortnight) and speak to their children every Friday for a period of 5 minutes instead of 3 minutes. . This will be on Fridays at the assigned time known to you.


During the ICSE examinations the parents can call on every day a paper has been taken by the children to find out how they have fared in that particular paper and provide the emotional support and encouragement required.

Children and parents can write as many letters as they wish to during the next two months.

Parents can visit the child on either the second or the third or the last Sunday of February, viz. any one day out of 14th or 21st or 28th of February for about 2 hours. It is recommended that the last Sunday the child is not taken out because it will be too close to the ICSE. **ONLY ONE VISIT PLEASE!** During the visit no eatables should be brought.

Please help us to focus upon the children by not disturbing our teachers at all. This is to remind you that the parents may not contact the teachers directly for any reason whatsoever.
